



Requirements for the Replacement and/or Renovation of Kitchen Cabinets

Effective December 1, 2009

- Layout plan of the Kitchen Area showing the location and dimensions of the cabinets. (1 set required)
- Elevation plan showing elevation of walls where cabinets are located, showing location of counters, top and bottom cabinets with dimensions of all cabinets. (1 set required)
- Elevation plans are to show the attachment of cabinets to the wall as per Manufacturer's Specification or Installation Procedures. Plans are also to show the type, size and amount of fasteners to be used on the installation.
- Plans submitted do not need to be signed and sealed, plans supplied by Cabinet Manufacturer or plans supplied by Home Depot or Lowes are acceptable as long as they have all the requirements mentioned above.
- If any Electrical, Plumbing or Mechanical upgrades or changes are being done as part of the Kitchen Cabinet project, they will also require a permit for each discipline.
 - Electrical permit shall be required for adding additional outlets, light fixtures, high hats, GFI's, etc. For any Electrical questions, please call Pete Deveaugh @ 954-597-3459.
 - Plumbing permit shall be required for the replacement of a sink or any water service done. For any Plumbing questions, please call, Cary Bauer @ 954-597-3441.
 - Mechanical permit shall be required for the replacement or new installation of an Exhaust Hood system if it is to be exhausted to the exterior. Recirculation exhaust fans over the Stove do not require permits. For any Mechanical questions, please call, Johnny Cruz @ 954-597-3440.
