



## CONTRIBUTION (CIAC) CHARGES

In addition to the physical connection and the installation of a meter for the determination of consumption for both the water and sewer system, the City shall charge a connection charge which represents the capital facility cost of the water and sewer system capacity utilized by the new connection.

The capital cost of the water and sewer capacity is calculated on an Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC) basis, which is defined as the maximum demand of three hundred fifty (350) gallons per day (GPD) which equates to the demand for a single-family dwelling unit. Meter size shall comply with the requirements of the South Florida Building Code.

Rate per ERC is as follows:

\*Future dumpster connections to sanitary sewer system shall pay CIAC sewer charges based on each dumpster being one (1) ERC.

\*Irrigation service connections for water use shall pay CIAC charges based on water consumption and will not be charged for sewer. If a well is going to be used instead of City water, a SFWM (South Florida Water Management) water use permit will be necessary.

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
